Going north on I-95 take Exit 5 to the Portsmouth traffic circle. Take the 3rd exit from the circle onto NH-16, the Spaulding Turnpike. Go 3.4 miles and take exit 4. Turn left after the exit and circle around under the highway. Turn right onto Nimble Hill. Town Hall is less than a mile down on the left.

Going south on I-95, exit 5 leads directly to NH-16 north, the Spaulding Turnpike. Then follow the above directions.

Going south on NH-16, take exit 4 for Newington. Turn right and the Town Hall is less than a mile down on the left.
