From I-93 take Exit 3. Turn left at the end of the ramp and proceed six miles on route 111 west. At the blinking light (the Great Eagle Motel is on your left), turn right on Lawrence Road, and an immediate right on Bockes road. The site is a quarter mile on the right.

From Route 3, take Exit 5 and follow Route 111 east. After crossing the bridge into Hudson, turn left after the third set of lights (still Rt. 111). Proceed about two miles until you see the blinking light with the Great Eagle Motel on your right. Take a left on Lawrence Road and an immediate right on Bockes Road. The site is a quarter mile on the right.
